

GBRT Grant Application Rules & Information

Eligibility Of Applicant:

- Live within 10 miles of Market Harborough, Leicestershire and be a permanent resident in the UK
- Student attending school in years 4 to 12
- Show particular promise and enthusiasm towards their instrument
- Have a commitment to playing their instrument in the future
- Requires financial assistance to progress on their chosen musical instrument
- Grants only considered to support the playing of one of the following orchestral instruments:
 - Woodwind: Flute, Oboe, Clarinet, Saxophone, Bassoon
 - Brass: Trumpet, Trombone, French Horn, Euphonium, Tuba
 - String: Violin, Viola, Violincello, Double Bass
 - Other: Piano, Percussion, Harp

Documents Required To Apply For A Grant:

The following documents should be sent to the address on the Grant Application form:

- A completed, signed Grant Application form
- A current passport photograph of the applicant signed and dated on the reverse by your instrumental teacher
- A completed Reference 1 document (See Grant Application Form) from the applicant's instrumental teacher
- A completed Reference 2 document (See Grant Application Form) from the applicant's school music teacher
- A copy of the applicant's most recent instrumental examination comments sheet, where possible
- A copy of your latest instrumental teacher's report, where possible

Application Process:

- 01 May each year: Grant Application forms must be completed, signed and returned along with all requested documentation.
- Early in June each year: Short-listed applicants will be invited to attend an audition as follows:
 - Perform one unaccompanied piece of an appropriate length to the applicant's ability and/or grade
 - Parent or guardian must attend so that any questions posed by the Trustees may be responded to
- 01 July each year: Notification of support will be communicated in writing.
- September each year: Support will commence to coincide with school term dates.

Conditions of Entry:

The applicant's parent/ guardian:

- Agrees to the Rules And Information of the Great Bowden Recital Trust.
- Is aware of this application and agrees for the details contained to be considered for financial support.
- Confirms that all details provided within this Grant Application form are, to the best of their knowledge, true and accurate.
- Understands that financial/instrumental support will be immediately withdrawn if any information provided is found to be either inaccurate or not in the spirit of the Great Bowden Recital Trust.
- The Great Bowden Recital Trust will not disclose any data provided on Grant Application Forms to any third party.
